Moved by Pic, seconded by Rost, to accept the bid from ICS, Inc. for \$368,975 for the Grand Forks County Parking Ramp Project. Motion carried unanimously.

Haley Wamstad, State's Attorney, informed the board, via telephone, that IRET Properties has appealed the Grand Forks County Commission decision to deny their abatements to District Court. The ND Insurance Reserve Fund has appointed an attorney, Mitch Armstrong, to represent Grand Forks County.

State's Attorney Wamstad said the State's Attorney Office, Public Health, Emergency Management and Tom Ford have been working to put together a process to establish a non-congregate shelter during the COVID-19 pandemic. This would be to establish a location for the quarantine or isolation of first responders, corrections employees and emergency management personnel that may be subject to occupational exposure of COVID-19.

Motion by Rost, seconded by Pic, to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 5:57pm. The next meeting will be held on April 21, 2020 at 4:00pm.
