Sheriff Rost and Lieutenant BJ Maxson addressed the board.

Moved by Engen, seconded by Knauf, to approve the Special Operations Group Joint Powers Agreement and Addendum 1. Motion carried unanimously.

Jay Kleven, AE2S, presented a revised Grand Forks County Fairground Grandstand Final Report.

The Chair appointed a committee to consider the options for the Fairgrounds. The following members were appointed: Commissioner Knauf, Commissioner Pic, Sheriff Rost, Mark Landa, Darren Evavold, and a representative from the Historical Society, Economic Development and Grand Forks City. Jay Kleven also volunteered to be on the committee, at no charge. The committee will meet October 16, 2018 at 2:00pm. Commissioner Knauf was appointed the Chair of the committee.

Nick West, County Engineer, addressed the board.

Moved by Knauf, seconded by Pic, to install a 40 mph speed zone on CR 81 through the Reynolds beet piler area. Motion carried unanimously.

Michele Thiel, Human Resource Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Knauf, seconded by Pic, to make no further exceptions, at this time, for Meredith Larson and to develop a policy that clearly addresses how years of service is calculated when employment status changes during continuous service. Motion failed with Knauf and Pic voting aye and Falck, Engen and Malm voting nay.

Moved by Malm, seconded by Engen, to add the 2.5 years Meredith Larson served part-time to her years of service with Grand Forks County for vacation accrual and longevity payments. Motion carried with Falck, Engen, Pic and Malm voting aye and Knauf voting nay.

Debbie Nelson, Finance and Tax Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Malm, seconded by Pic, to establish an Early Voting Precinct at the Alerus Center, October 30 – November 2, 2018, 10:00am – 6:00pm and November 3, 2018, 10:00am – 3:00pm. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Malm, seconded by Engen, to give Ms. Nelson the authority to call an Absentee Ballot Precinct if the volume of absentee ballots received exceeds the amount that can be effectively managed at the polling site on Election Day. Motion carried unanimously.

Tom Ford, Government Relations Administrator, addressed the board.

Moved by Pic, seconded by Malm, to accept the proposal from ICS to repair the County Office Building north and south employee entrance stairs for \$39,577. This will be paid from the capital improvements line item. Motion carried unanimously.

David Jones, States Attorney, addressed the board.

The board directed Mr. Jones to work in collaboration with Howard Swanson, Grand Forks City Attorney, on how to proceed with the potential opioid litigation.

The Chair directed Ms. Nelson to notify all Department Managers to submit all budgeted out-of-state travel requests to the Commission in writing. There will be no requirement to appear unless the expense was not budgeted.

Moved by Pic, seconded by Knauf, to approve the Court Services Contracts between the State of North Dakota, Grand Forks County and the City of Grand Forks. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion by Malm, seconded by Engen, to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:09pm. The next meeting will be held on September 4, 2018 at 4:00pm.
