GRAND FORKS COUNTY COMMISSION MEETING February 1, 2005 – 4:00 P.M.

The Board met pursuant to adjournment with Commissioners Murphy, Kvasager, Yahna, Malm and Triplett present. Commissioner Triplett participated via telephone from Bismarck.

Moved by Kvasager, seconded by Yahna, to approve the minutes of the January 18, 2005 meeting as corrected. Motion carried.

Moved by Malm, seconded by Triplett, to approve the order of agenda. Motion carried.

Moved by Triplett, seconded by Malm, to approve the consent agenda. Items in the consent agenda included employee status changes, bills as submitted by the County Auditor, Check #34283 thru Check #34430 in the amount of \$645,471.49, approval of overtime, approval of bond for check reissue and County Deeds on 44-2931-00008-000 and 42-0001-00042-000. Motion carried.

Robert Twedt addressed the board.

Moved by Kvasager, seconded by Yahna, to approve the States Attorney to draft an agreement between the County and Robert Twedt, to allow Mr. Twedt to apply to the City of Grand Forks for a side yard variance on the northwest 25' of lot 7, block 3, Original Townsite, Grand Forks and if the variance is approved to allow him to purchase the property from the County. Motion carried.

Moved by Triplett, seconded by Malm, approve the purchase of a switch for the Sheriff's Department for \$3600 from the Computer Department's budget. Motion carried.

Moved by Triplett, seconded by Malm, to sign a resolution in support of SB2268 which is a bill for an Act to provide for waste rubber recycling, abatement and remediation of waste rubber tire stockpiles, and to recover the components of petroleum-based products. Motion carried with Triplett, Malm and Kvasager voting aye and Yahna and Murphy voting nay.
