Moved by Schmisek, seconded by Pic, to approve the minutes of the February 3, 2015 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Pic, seconded by Schmisek, to approve the order of the agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Falck, seconded by Schmisek, to approve the consent agenda.
