Moved by Knauf, seconded by Rost, to amend the grant period, originally approved October 6, 2020 and extend the employment period to May 2022, with no additional cost, to add a full-time nurse to work in the medical office at the GF County Correctional Center to respond to the increased workload because of COVID-19. Coronavirus Relief Funds will be used to cover the additional cost of \$82,450. Motion carried unanimously.

Kari Goelz, Emergency Management Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Knauf, seconded by Engen, to designate Gannon Engkvist, Grand Forks County Emergency Management, the authority to enter into legal agreements on behalf of Grand Forks County for the purpose of a developer agreement and establishing a Grand Forks County Emergency Preparedness application for the Apple platform. Motion carried unanimously.

Becky Ault, Public Safety Answering Point Director, gave the 2020 Annual Report.

Nick West, County Engineer, addressed the board.

Kari Goelz, Emergency Management Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Engen, seconded by Falck, to authorize Mr. West to get two appraisals on the property located at 1548 30<sup>th</sup> Ave NE, Manvel as required by the FEMA Flood Buyout Program at a cost not to exceed \$6,000. The cost will be paid from cash carryforward in the general fund. Motion carried unanimously.

Michele Thiel, Human Resource Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Knauf, seconded by Rost, to approve adopting a temporary increase in dependent care flexible spending as outlined by the American Recovery Plan Act, effective immediately. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Falck, seconded by Engen, to approve adopting the IRS dollar limits for employee contributions to both dependent care and medical flexible spending, effective January 1, 2022. Motion carried unanimously.

The Military Installation Readiness Grant will be discussed at the May 18, 2021 Commission Meeting.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Falck, to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 5:28pm. The next meeting will be held on May 18, 2021 at 4:00pm.
