

GRAND FORKS COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION

June 7, 2022

The board met as provided by NDCC section 57-12-01 with Commissioners Falck, Rost, and Engen present. Commissioner Knauf and Pic were absent.

Amber Gudajtes, Tax Equalization Director, addressed the board.

Ms. Gudajtes provided a preliminary comparison of the 2021 and 2022 Taxable Values and the Agricultural Values per acre for the 2022 Assessment from the State Tax Department. There was no change to agricultural this year.

The first order of business was the equalization of assessments in Cities.

No appeals were heard from property owners in any city in Grand Forks County.

Moved by Engen, seconded by Rost, to approve the 2022 assessments for Northwood City because they were not able to hold their City Board of Equalization meeting due to inclement weather. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Engen, seconded by Rost, to approve the 2022 assessments for all cities and classes of property as returned by the City Boards of Equalization. Motion carried unanimously.

The second order of business was the equalization of assessments in Townships.

There were no appeals from property owners in any township in Grand Forks County.

Moved by Engen, seconded by Rost, to approve the 2022 assessments for Grace, Inkster, Niagara and Walle Townships because they were not able to hold the Township Board of Equalization meeting because of inclement weather. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Engen, to approve the 2022 assessments for all townships and classes of property as returned by the Township Boards of Equalization. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Engen, to adjourn the Board of Equalization. Motion carried unanimously.
