Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to solicit for bids for chip sealing approximately 33 miles of CR 1,6, 10, 17 & 19. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Pic, to reject RDO Truck Centers bid for a 6x4 snowplow and readvertise for two plow trucks. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to build a salt storage shed on the Highway Department's lot at a cost not to exceed \$400,000 using the legacy fund disbursement. Motion carried unanimously.

Tom Ford, County Administrator, addressed the board.

Moved by Pic, seconded by Rost, to approve the contract with JLG Architects for a Grand Forks County Space Utilization Study with the Chair's signature. Motion carried unanimously.

Debbie Nelson, Finance and Tax Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to approve the following 2023 county budget amendments: 2150 Highway Fund - \$260,000, 2169 FEMA-2022 Spring Flooding - \$5,500, 2170 FEMA-2023 Spring Flooding - \$168,000, 3003 \$5 Million Dome Bank of ND Loan - \$23,000 All funds had offsetting non-budgeted revenues or cash carryforward. Motion carried unanimously.

Debbie Nelson, Finance and Tax Director, encouraged all North Dakota homeowners to apply for the Primary Residence credit. You must reside in your primary residence and apply online by March 31, 2024 to get the credit of up to \$500 on your 2024 property tax bill.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to approve the Washington Township Agreement for Performance of Assessing Duties with the Chair's signature. Motion carried unanimously.
