By the order of the Board of County Commissioners of Grand Forks County, North Dakota, I hereby give notice that sealed bids shall be received by the undersigned at the office of the County Director of Finance & Tax up until 1:00 o'clock p.m., April 22, 2024. Bids shall be publicly opened and read at 1:00 o'clock p.m. for County Road 3 & Emery Ave Culvert Extensions. Approximate major quantities are: 60LF 8'x8' RCBC, 2EA 8'x8' RCBC End Sections, 60LF 5'x5' RCBC, 2EA 5'x5' RCBC End Sections, 120LF 60" Smooth Wall Steel Pipe, 7,010CY Riprap, 4,100CY Borrow Material. The bids shall be considered at the May 7, 2024 regularly scheduled Commission meeting.

Bids shall be submitted on bidding blanks and in accordance with the approved bidder's instructions and specifications prepared by and available at the office of the County Highway Department, 1700 N Columbia Road, Grand Forks ND 58203

In compliance with Section 11-11-28 of the North Dakota Century Code, bids to be opened and considered must be accompanied by a bond. A bid shall be accompanied by a separate envelope containing a bidder's bond in a sum equal to five percent of the full amount of the bid, executed by the bidders as principal and by a surety company authorized to do business in the State as a guaranty that the bidder will enter into the contract if it is awarded to him, and that he will furnish the necessary bond. The bidder's bond envelope must be on the outside of the bid package. Each bid shall contain a copy of the license or certificate of renewal thereof issued by the secretary of state enclosed in the required bid bond envelope. Bidder must be licensed for the full amount of the bid. Each bid shall contain copy of the certificate of insurance.

The Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, in whole or in part, and to waive any technicalities.

The Board reserves the right to extend the date for receiving and opening of bids for a period of not to exceed five days when unforeseeable events may warrant such extension, at the discretion of the Board.

Bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope, with a separate envelope for the bidder's bond, both addressed to the County Director of Finance & Tax and marked on the outside what the bid is for. The County Director of Finance & Tax office is located at 151 4th Street South and there mailing address is P.O. Box 5726, Grand Forks, ND 58206.

LEGAL NOTICE

GRAND FORKS COUNTY HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS

- I. Proposals are requested for the construction of CR 3 & Emery Ave Culvert Extensions. Grand Forks County Highway Department Project No. NA, in accordance with Plans, North Dakota Standard Specification Manual, North Dakota Supplemental Specification and other Contract Documents prepared by the Grand Forks County Highway Department.
 - A. <u>Form</u>: Each Proposal shall be made in a form prepared there for by the Engineer and included as one of the Contract Documents. All bids and proposals shall contain a statement showing that the bidder or contractor is dully and regularly licensed in the State of North Dakota. The number and class of the license then held by the contractor shall appear upon each bid or proposal. No contract shall be awarded to any contractor unless he is a holder of a license in the class within which the value of the project shall fall as hereinbefore provided. A contractor must be the holder of a license at least ten days prior to the date set for receiving bids to be qualified bidder. The bid shall be submitted in a sealed envelope upon which there is disclosed the following information:
 - 1. The class of license held by the bidder;
 - 2. The number of the bidder's license;
 - 3. The name of the person, firm or corporation submitting the bid;
 - 4. Date on which license was issued or renewed.
 - 5. Certification of Insurance not less than 1,000,000.00 dollars.

A bid submitted without this information on the envelope shall not be considered and shall be returned to the bidder.

- B. <u>Modifications</u>; Proposal shall not contain any recapitulation of the work to be done. Alternate proposals will not be considered unless called for. Oral proposals or modification will not be considered.
- C. Examination of Contract Documents and Visit to Site;

Before submitting proposal, Bidder's shall carefully examine the Plans, read the Specification and the other Contract Document, shall visit the site of work, and shall fully inform themselves as to all existing conditions, and limitations, and shall include in the proposal a sum to cover the cost of items included in the Contract Documents.

- D. <u>Deliver of Proposal</u>; Proposals shall be delivered by the time and the place stipulated in the Advertisement. It is the sole responsibility of the Bidder to see that his proposal received in proper time. Any proposal received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of proposals shall be returned to the Bidder unopened.
- E. <u>Withdrawal</u>; Any Bidder may withdrawal his proposal, either personally or by written request, at any time prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of proposals.

- F. <u>Opening</u>; Proposals will be opened and publicly read aloud at the time and place set forth in the Advertisement.
- G. <u>Award or Rejection</u>; The Contract will be awarded to the lowest and/or best qualified responsible Bidder complying with those instructions and with the Advertisement. Grand Forks County reserves the right to reject any or all proposals or to waive any informalities or technicality in any proposal in the interest of Grand Forks County. No bidder may withdraw his proposal for a period of 30 days after the date of opening thereof.
- INTERPRETATION OF DOCUMENTS; If any person contemplating submitting a proposal is in doubt as to the true meaning of a part of the Plans, Specifications or other Contract Documents, or finds discrepancies in or omissions from the Plans or Specifications, he may submit to the Engineer a written request for an interpretation or correction thereof. The person submitting the request will be responsible for its prompt delivery. Any interpretation or correction of the documents will be made only by Addendum duly issued and a copy of the Addendum will be mailed or delivered to each person receiving a set of the Contract Documents. Neither the County nor the Engineer will be responsible for any other explanation or interpretation of the Contract Documents.
- ADDENDA; Any addenda issued during the time of bidding, or forming part of the Contract Documents loaned to the Bidder for the preparation of his proposal, shall be covered in the proposal, and shall be made a part of the Contract. Receipt of each Addendum shall be acknowledged in the proposal.
- IV <u>BIDDERS INTERESTED IN MORE THAN ONE PROPOSAL</u>; No person, firm or corporation shall be allowed to make, file or to be interested in more than one proposal for the same work, unless alternate proposals are called for. A person firm or corporation who has submitted a sub-proposal to a Bidder's, or who has quoted prices on materials to a Bidder's is not herby disqualified from submitting a sub-proposal or quoting prices to other Bidder's.
- V <u>PROPOSAL GUARANTY</u>: Each bid must be accompanied by a bidder's bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid, payable to Grand Forks County. All bonds shall comply with the North Dakota Century Code as amended. Bond shall be in a separate envelope.

All such bonds will be returned to the respective unsuccessful Bidder's within ten days after the award is made, except those the County elects to hold until the successful Bidder has executed the Contract. Thereafter all remaining bonds will be returned within ten days.



GOVERNING SPECIFICATIONS: The latest edition of the North Dakota Department of Transportation "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" along with any general pravisions and the special provisions contained in the general notes of these plans for box culvert extensions and Smooth Wall Steel Pipe installation between Sections 1 & 12, Chester Township & incidentals AND box culvert extensions between Section 12, Chester Township and Section 7 Oakville Township & incidentals.

GENERAL NOTES

Scope of Work: Project consists of removal/disposal of existing wood culvert extension, clearing and grubbing, the installation of two 5 feet x 5 feet precast concrete box culvert extensions, the installation of a 60" long smooth wall steel pipe inside existing 72" CMP, and the installation of two 8 feet x 8 feet precast concrete box culvert extensions, installation and compaction of foundation fill and incidentals. The Contractor shall coordinate with RCBC and smooth steel wall pipe supplier for delivery. Contractor shall be available to unload from delivery truck and shall be considered incidental to furnishing and installing culverts and aprons.

Bid Price: Contractor shall furnish Grand Forks County bid for all work required to complete the project as described in these notes and shown on these plans. Contractor is encouraged to visit site prior to bidding work. The quote shall include an expected schedule of work.

Completion Date: November 1, 2024 - The road shall be closed a maximum of 5 days, unless otherwise approved.

<u>Utilities</u> The Contractor will be responsible for verifying utility locations, contacting the utility companies, and having utilities marked and flagged prior to construction. For the State of North Dakota, the locate number is 1-800-795-0555 or 811. If it becomes necessary, the Contractor shall coordinate, cooperate and assist any utility company in relocating their utilities during construction.

Utilities may exist. Actual locations shall be verified by the Contractor. The Contractor will be liable for any costs resulting from damage to utilities or pipelines.

Work by County Resources: Grand Forks County will be completing all traffic control, seeding of all finished earthwork construction and delineator installation. The Contractor shall coordinate with the County so that work may be completed as quickly as possible.

Disposal of Wood Culvert Extension: Waste material shall become property of the Contractor and be hauled to an approved inert disposal site.

Topsoil: All disturbed embankment areas shall require removal and replacement of the topsoil. Removed topsoil shall be stockpiled and respread prior to seeding.

Channel Excavation: Channel bottom excavation is required in the installation of the new concrete box culvert. All excess material shall be wasted onsite at direction of Engineer. No excavated material can be wasted into a designated wetland.

Box Culvert Foundation Preparation/Foundation Fill: The channel bed where the new culvert to be installed shall be excavated to an elevation of 17" below the culvert invert, type R1 Geotextile Fabric shall be placed under 2 feet of foundation fill. Foundation fill shall be Class 5, Class 13, or recycled crushed concrete material.

Smooth Wall Steel Pipe Preparation: A 1/4" rod shall be welded on each end of new culvert for installation of flared end sections. The new culvert shall be braced above and filled with controlled density fill to fill in any gaps between new smooth wall steep pipe and old CMP culvert and to keep new culvert from moving. Shall follow NDDOT Spec. No. 714 and 830, minimum wall thickness 0.719 inches.

Foundation Preparation: The bidders shall be aware of the possibility of inundated conditions at this site before the bid opening. The cost of any coffer dams and dewatering the excavation shall be included in the bid price.

Irraffic Control: Traffic control shall be completed by County Resources. The Contractor shall coordinate timing of road closure with County Engineer.

Signs and Delinineators: Any existing signs and delineator posts will be removed by contractor and reset by Grand Forks County Highway Department personnel.

Precast Concrete Box Culverts: The installation of the precast RCBs shall satisfy the applicable portions of "AASHTO Standard Specifications for Highway Bridges", Division II, Section 27 and Section 2 along with Section 210 of the "North Dakota Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction."

The end sections include two reinforced concrete cutoff walls below the floor on each side of the culvert. The cutoff walls shall be placed under the end sections of the box culvert and shall be a minimum of 12 inches thick, 3 feet deep, and three feet longer than the barrel section is wide. Holes shall be cast at 3' centers through the floor of each end section and into the cutoff walls to receive 3/4" diameter dowels. Then the void shall be filled with grout.

All the RCB sections shall be tied together by an acceptable method. The ties should adequately hold the sections together under construction load and service load conditions. The sections shall be tied together. If U-bolts are used, the four u-bolts will be located at the third points of the outside walls. The hardware shall either be hot-dipped galvanized according to Section 854 of the "North Dakota Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" or mechanically galvanized according to ASTM B695. Steal cable ties shall be corrosion protected and their ends grouted.

All four sides of each barrel section joint shall be wrapped with a geotextile fabric that prevent soil from leaking through the joint. In addition, an approved water tight joint sealant shall be placed at each interior joint location. The water tight sealant shall extend across the bottom of each joint and extend up 1/3 of the box culvert height at each side. The geotextile fabric shall be a minimum of 24 inches wide and shall meet the requirements of geotextile separation fabric of Section 709 of the "North Dakota Supplemental Specifications." Geotextile fabric shall also be required at the outside of each cutoff wall vertical joint, if more than one unit is used. A groove should be made in the bedding 1" deep and 2" - 3" wide in front of each joint to prevent sand from being pushed into the joint during installation.

The box culvert shall be mechanically backfilled equally on both sides of the box to avoid uneven loading to one side of the culvert in maximum lifts of 8-inches.

The costs of providing and installing the ties, geotextile fabric and sealant shall be included in bid price.

The join! belween existing Grand Forks County Road No. 3 10' x 10' box culvert and proposed box culvert shall be reinforced with 4" angle iron anchored to both boxes.

The joint between existing Emery Street 5' x 5' box culvert and proposed box culvert shall be reintorced with steel plates anchored to both boxes.

Riprap: Riprap fabric shall be installed by contractor under riprap.
