No one appeared to make public comment.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to close the Public Hearing on the MIDA Bonds for Spectra Health project. Motion carried unanimously.

Scott Wegner, Arntson Stewart Wegner PC, addressed the board via Zoom.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to approve the resolution authorizing the issuance of an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 Healthcare Facilities Revenue Bonds for the Spectra Health Project, Series 2024. Motion carried on roll call vote with Rost, Rustad, Hagen and Engen voting aye. It appears that the impact and effect of the issue upon existing industry and business will not result in an unfair advantage for the proposed project to the substantial detriment of existing enterprises. Grand Forks County assumes no financial responsibility. The bonds will be subject to an administration fee of 1% of the total issuance, with a maximum of \$10,000. A copy of the resolution is on file at the County Finance and Tax Office.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to recess the County Commission Board meeting and to convene the County Board of Equalization. Motion carried unanimously. It was 4:07pm.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to recess the County Board of Equalization and reconvene the County Commission Board meeting. Motion carried unanimously. It was 4:18pm.

Tom Ford, County Administrator, Dawn Mandt, Red River Regional Council Executive Director, Keith Lund, GF Regional Economic Development President, Lisa Rotvold, Red River Regional Council and Jake Lanes, Emerado Mayor, addressed the board regarding the Preservation and Reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Hagen, to approve a Memorandum of Understanding between Red River Regional Council and Grand Forks County, a \$20,000 contribution and a letter of support for the Preservation and Reinvestment Initiative for Community Enhancement application. Motion carried with Engen, Hagen and Rost voting aye. Commissioner Rustad recused himself because of a conflict of interest.

Lane Magnuson, County Planner, address the board.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to temporarily suspend the enforcement of state building code until a suitable replacement can be found for building permitting and building inspections. Motion carried unanimously.

Nick West, County Engineer, addressed the board.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to approve the bid of \$5,300,434.20 from RJ Zavoral & Sons on the FXS-1838(056) CR 25 Paving Project, with the Chair's signature on the contract, contingent on NDDOT approval and receipt of the Contractors Performance and Payment Bonds. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to approve the Construction Engineering Contract with KLJ for the FXS-1838(056) project. Motion carried unanimously.

Gracie Lian, Project Coordinator, addressed the board.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to approve County Administrator Tom Ford to submit a Defense Community Infrastructure Program grant proposal on behalf of Grand Forks County to the Office of Local Defense Community Cooperation for non-match grant dollars between \$10 million and \$11 million in order to construct a Fire Station on Grand Sky, and to designate the County Administrator as the submitting official and authorized representative of the county. Motion carried unanimously.

Tom Ford, County Administrator, addressed the board.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to share in the cost to repair a fence damaged in a winter storm located on the fairgrounds. Grand Forks County will pay fifty percent of the estimated cost of \$11,910 from capital improvements. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to approve the increase parking fees as follows: first and second level parking ramps spots will be \$50 per month, third floor parking ramp fees will be \$25 per month, and the Courthouse parking lot fees will be \$25 per month. All reserved parking spots are M-F, 7:00am – 5:00pm, fleet and residential are 24/7. The new parking fees will be effective when parking fees are reinstated. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Hagen, seconded by Rustad, to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 5:20pm. The next meeting will be held on June 18, 2024 at 4:00pm.
