Moved by Pic, seconded by Rost, to approve the Application for Permission to hold a Public Display of Fireworks by Larimore Dam Recreation Area on July 6<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

Grand Forks County Commission requested the ND Department of Transportation add County 5 and US Highway 2 intersection as a priority to the list of projects to complete. Ed Pavlish, NDDOT District Engineer said they need the support of the community to make this happen.

Nick West, County Engineer, addressed the board.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to approve a letter of support for EDA Disaster Relief Funding for the Epitome Energy Application with the Chair's signature. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to waive the technicality in the bid by Ault Construction of not placing their contractor's license in a separate envelope and accept their low bid of \$349,000 for the Northwood Shed Project contingent upon the land purchase from ADM. Motion carried with Rost, Rustad and Hagen voting aye and Pic and Engen voting nay.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to remove the truck speed limits as presented and to change the speed limit on CR 25 to 55 mph for all vehicles after the road is paved. Motion carried unanimously.

Sheriff Schneider gave an update on the Sheriff Relocation Committee discussions and provided a Request for Proposal that he drafted. He asked the Commission to let him know the length of term for the lease and any other ideas for the RFP.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to approve the purchase of two snowmobiles at cost of \$11,000 each from Devils Lake Marine. The cost has been budgeted within the Sheriff's Department budget. Motion carried unanimously.

Haley Wamstad, State's Attorney, addressed the board.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to add additional defendants to the Opioid Litigation Settlement Agreement as provided by the Plaintiff's Executive Committee as provided in correspondence dated July 2, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Pic, to approve the reclassification of the Recorder Assistant position to a Deputy Recorder position from a grade 8 to a grade 10, effective July 1, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Hagen, seconded by Rustad, to a meeting will be held on July 16, 2024 at 4:0	djourn. The meeting adjourned at 5:28pm. The next 00pm.
