Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to approve the Chair's signature on a letter to US Senator John Hoeven asking for his continued support of the Defense Community Infrastructure Program. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Hagen, to approve the reimbursement for damage to a parking ramp lessee's vehicle sustained in the Grand Forks County Parking Ramp on June 18, 2024 at a cost of \$924.06. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, to approve closing the Grand Forks County Parking Ramp from Monday, July 22, 2024 until further notice which will most likely be the end of October. Motion carriedunanimously.
