Tammy Knutson, GF County Human Service Zone Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Pic, to approve the purchase of a 2025 Ford Explorer for \$39,784 from Nelson Auto Center, Fergus Falls, MN through the State bid. Motion carried unanimously. The ND Department of Health and Human Services has approved the purchase, and she has the funds within the Human Service Zone 2024 budget. She will also be trading in a 2014 Grand Caravan that will off set the cost of the new vehicle.

Lou Lombardi, Veterans Service Officer, addressed the board.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Hagen, to approve the Grand Forks County Resolution Supporting Operation Green Light for Veterans and to approve the Letter to Editor regarding Operation Green Light for Veterans with the Chair's signatures. Motion carried unanimously.

Michele Thiel, Human Resources Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Pic, seconded by Hagen, for Grand Forks County to affirm to North Dakota Public Employees Retirement System that Grand Forks County is formed pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 11-01-01 and 11-01-19 and is neither a non-profit corporation nor a for-profit corporation, to join the NDPERS Deferred Compensation Plan and offer the plan to all eligible employees of Grand Forks County. The Board approved joining the NDPERS Deferred Compensation Plan effective January 1, 2025. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Rost, to approve offering matching funds, up to 3% of employee contributions to a 457 plan. This for all new employees, effective January 1, 2025. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Rustad, for Grand Forks County to enroll into the NDPERS 457 plan for all new employees, effective January 1, 2025. Motion carried unanimously.

Tom Ford, County Administrator, addressed the board.

Moved by Hagen, seconded by Rost, to accept Heartland Acres Development's proposal for relocation of the Sheriff's Office contingent upon Measure #4 failing on the November 5, 2024 General Election ballot. Motion carried with Rost, Hagen, Pic and Engen voting aye. Commissioner Rustad recused himself from the vote.

Debbie Nelson, Finance and Tax Director, addressed the board.

Moved by Pic, seconded by Rost, to approve the appraised value of the real estate acquired by tax deed and to set the minimum sale price at the amount of 3 years taxes due, plus special assessments, penalties, interest and costs, plus an amount equal to the estimated taxes and special assessments for the current assessment year and set the Property Appraisal hearing for November 5, 2024 at 4:00pm. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Pic, to approve the Notices of Intent to Evict. Motion carried unanimously.

Tom Swoyer, Grand Sky Development Company, addressed the board.

Moved by Rustad, seconded by Hagen, to approve an amount not to exceed \$863,330 from the 21-23.036 Grand Forks Enhanced Use Lease Development Grant for improvements to the Beyond Visual Line of Sight system by Thales. The board waives the competitive procurement because Thales is the sole source provider with the necessary intellectual property. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Rost, seconded by Pic, to approve the Agreement with Curry & Co. Solutions, LLC for Implementing a Strategic Plan and Consulting Services to support and enhance GFAFB and GrandSKY for a total cost not to exceed \$48,000 plus reimbursables up to \$10,000. The 2024 County Administrator budget will absorb up to \$10,000 and \$50,000 will come from the 21-23.036 Grand Forks Enhanced Use Lease Development Grant. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Pic, seconded by Hagen, to approve the ARPA Beneficiary Agreement with the Community Violence Intervention Center for \$333,622 net of the in-kind contributions and office space, to be paid in 2025 and to approve the Chair's signature. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Hagen, seconded by Rost, to approve the Lease Agreement with Community Violence Intervention Center for an in-kind contribution of 1,126 square feet of office space on the 5th floor north of the County Office Building and 154 square feet of office space on the 2nd floor of the Grand Forks County Courthouse and 1,160 square feet of office space on the 5th floor north of the County Office Building for annual rent of \$18,096. Rent shall be paid in advance by the 15th of each month in an amount \$1,508, commencing on October 15, 2024. Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Hagen, seconded by Rustad, to adjourn. The meeting adjourned at 5:29pm. The next meeting will be held on November 5, 2024 at 4:00pm.
